	— James 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. (CSB)
	— Malachi 3:6 "Because I, the LORD, have not changed, you descendants of Jacob have not been destroyed. (CSB)
	— Isaiah 46:9-10 Remember what happened long ago, for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and no one is like me. I declare the end from the beginning, and from long ago what is not yet done, saying: my plan will take place, and I

will do all my will. (CSB)

— **Genesis 1:1** | In the beginning God created the heavens

— Psalm 139:7-12 | Where can I go to escape your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to heaven, you are there; if I make my bed in Sheol, you are there. If I live at the eastern horizon or settle at the western limits, even there your hand will lead me; your right hand will hold on to me. If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me, and the light around me will be night"— even the darkness is not dark to you. The night shines like the day; darkness and light are alike to you. (CSB)

- **Psalm 135:6** | *The LORD does whatever he pleases in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all the depths.* (CSB)
- Scripture emphasizes God's rule in three areas...
 - Creation
 - Mark 4:39 | He got up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Silence! Be still!" The wind ceased, and there was a great calm. (CSB)
 - Romans 8:20-21 | For the creation was subjected to futility—not willingly, but because of him who subjected it—in the hope that the creation itself will also be set free from the bondage to decay into the glorious freedom of God's children. (CSB)

— Human history

- **Proverbs 16:9** | *A person's heart plans his way, but the LORD determines his steps.* (CSB)
- Acts 17:26 | From one man he has made every nationality to live over the whole earth and has determined their appointed times and the boundaries of where they live. (CSB)

— Romans 8:29 | For those he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, so that he would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. (CSB)
